The Aspermont Equity Rotator Basket

The Actively Managed Certificate (AMC) linked to the Aspermont Equity Rotator Basket gives investors the opportunity to invest in a dynamic, broadly diversified European equity portfolio. Since investments are made exclusively in indices, stock-specific risks are eliminated. The strategy is designed to give the manager the opportunity to add direct sector exposure to country allocations, as well as the capacity to short sectors or countries with a particularly negative outlook. Target weightings are determined by both fundamental and technical aspects and are continuously reviewed and adjusted as necessary. We place emphasis on the relative strength indicator (RSI), which is a technical momentum indicator that compares the magnitude of recent gains to recent losses of the asset to identify overbought and oversold conditions. Event-driven opportunities may also be exploited as they occur through combinations of long and short strategies.

Manager's Comment

Aspermont European Rotator Basket performed +0.90% in May, beating the DAX that was down -0.06% and the EuroStoxx600 that was down -0.59%. Currently, the portfolio is invested in 19 positions; 16 sectors (68% of AuM) and 3 countries (26% of AuM).

During May the performances were mostly positive with some strong performers. The biggest weight, Technology (5.05%, 15.8% allocation) was not only the strongest performer but also the biggest contributor (+0.80% contribution) led by SAP (+4.24%) that announced a collaboration with Accenture and ASML (+6.29%) who got upgraded by several analysts. Both of these stocks make up more than 50% of the sector. Infineon Technologies' +10% (7% sector allocation) also helped the index as they got upgraded on the basis of a solid quarter and full order books going forward. Travel & Leisure (+4.38%, 1.1% allocation) came as a surprise as the US Supreme Court struck down the federal law that bars gambling on individual sporting events, this news led to the +26.91% May performance of Paddy Power Betfair (16% of the sector) as it unleashes potential billions of dollars of legal wagers. Ryan Air (+5.38%, 21% of the sector) performed strong after posting record annual profit. Health Care (+4.10% 1% allocation) profited from Bayer, where the deal with Monsanto is coming closer to final approval. Industrial goods and services (+1.65%, 8% allocation) contributed 0.20% to the performance of the basket as Siemens increased their full year guidance in May.

The negative performer, Banks (-13.81%, 2.1% allocation) was hit hard by the Italian and Spanish political uncertainties that not only took a toll on the Italian and Spanish banks, but also on the others who hold securities of these countries. Prior to the political turmoil, we reduced the allocation to banks by 50%, therefore dampening the negative contribution to -0.34%.



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
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
