
The Aspermont Dividend Stock Basket

The Actively Managed (Strategy) Certificate (AMC) linked to the Aspermont Capital Dividend Stock Basket provides investors access to a broadly diversified portfolio of around 30 attractive value stocks. We particularly seek out companies with stable or growing dividends and payout ratios, driven by healthy balance sheet structures and sustainable revenue and earnings growth. While screening for such quantitative elements as margin growth, free cash flow and debt-to-equity ratios, qualitative aspects like management performance and corporate strategy are also included in our selection process. A minimum of 80% of the portfolio will be invested in large cap names with market capitalizations of over EUR 10 billion.

Manager's Comment

The MSCI index rose 3.17% over the course of Dec, while other worldwide indices had the following performance in Dec: S&P 500 +2.78%, DAX +3.31% SMI +5.29% change and FTSE +3.28%. The currency distribution at the end of the month: 46.20% invested in EUR; 37.86% in USD; 10.21% in CHF; 5.73% in DKK. The basket is currently composed of 27 companies with the following sector allocation: Industrials is the largest with 14.20%; 13.43% Food, Beverage and Tobacco, 12% Technology, 11.09% Health Care, 8.52% Consumer Products and Services, 5.87% Materials, 5.67% Chemicals, 5.13% Financial Services, 4.39% Travel and Leisure, 4.21% Media, 3.97% Energy, 2.98% Utilities, 2.95% Telecommunications, 2.89% Insurance, 2.21% Auto & Parts, 0.49% Real Estate. The basket performed 1.85% in December.

Top 3 performers of the year were Microsoft (55.98%), Apple (48.66%), and Novo Nordisk (47.78%) with the highest weights: 6.1%, 5.4% and 6.0%, respectively. One of the top additions in 2023 was Apple with the very strong operating income and cashflow throughout the year. Another best addition in 2023 were Hemes Intl (34.82%) and Deutsche Telecom (15.81%). The weakest stock was Münchener Rück -4.31% perf (2.9% weight) due to a macroeconomic uncertainties and inflationary pressures, but analysts see improvement for the risk portfolio management and reduction of major loses. On the other hand, Bayer +8.10% perf (1.7% weight) had many challenges and court battles over the year. As a result of these difficulties the price has fallen 76% from its highs but analyst predict turnaround with the new CEO Bill Anderson who raised the possibility of a demerger of a company. The company also recently benefited from the announcement of a favorable court decision in California after a long battle.



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
